GROUP COUNSELOR

Rolling River is a family-owned and operated summer camp and event venue offering all-inclusive recreational youth programs in aquatics, arts and sciences, athletics, and more for children ages 3-15 on a private riverside campus.

EXPECTATIONS



BE HERE- Staff are expected to work for 38 days of camp from 8:20am-4:20pm. Staff must attend pre-season orientations and designated after camp activities.



BE PRESENT- Staff members are expected to be present and engaging at camp. Staff should participate in camp activities, showcase a positive attitude and act as an exemplary role model.



BE RESPECTFUL- Staff are expected to follow the chain of command. Staff must use an appropriate tone of voice and exhibit good manners. Staff work as a team to achieve a common goal.

COMPENSATION

- Group positions include a **base level** of compensation, with an opportunity to earn **additional pay** through **gratuities**.
- **Average Gratuity Suggestions** (Full Season per Camper) with 15-20 campers per group: \$45/HS, \$55/College, \$85/Adult Head
- Final compensation is determined by factors such as **grade level, position type, prior experience, years of employment at Rolling River, and any tuition required for children**.
- Summer camps in New York State are **exempt from minimum wage requirements**, and all compensation is offered as seasonal pay for the full summer.
- Payroll is distributed on the **final day of camp**; however, staff may elect to split their pay and receive half at the summer midpoint.

JOB OVERVIEW



A Group Counselor is assigned to oversee and supervise a specific age group at camp. Groups are created based on grade and gender and may include 12-28 campers. Each group is assigned an adult head counselor, 2 or 3 assistant student counselors and 1 or 2 CITs (counselors in training).

RESPONSIBILITIES



Oversee daily well-being of assigned camp group; Follow provided schedule and escort campers to required activities; Assist campers with two daily swim periods; Set up and clean up during lunch and snack periods; Help campers to restroom or Health Center; Participate in camp activities and dress up for Special Event days; Supervise campers for off-campus trips; Collaborate with team by assigning accountability for camp tasks; Correspond with parents (head counselors)

QUALIFICATIONS



Head positions 21+ years old; Assistant positions minimally entering 11th grade; Background in teaching and/or previous camp experience encouraged but not required; Ability to participate in indoor and outdoor camp activities; Spirited and enthusiastic demeanor; Experience with children; Organized and responsible

CREW PERKS

In addition to compensation, Crew Members at can earn extra income through six special add-on opportunities: Bus Transportation Staff, AM or PM Care Staff, Event Staff, Athletics Supervision, Babysitting & Services List, and the Camp Ambassador Referral Program. Crew also receive complimentary uniform and apparel, enjoy access to the Crew Lounge with a coffee bar and snacks, and are provided with all meals and refreshments. Plus, Crew Members may earn community service hours or internship credits and can request letters of recommendation for future school or job opportunities.
